





SPCC Reports

Report "Partnership, Knowledge, Development. The impact of Scandinavian companies on the Polish economy". A round anniversary is a good reason to reflect on the past and design the future better.

SPCC Report for the 20th Anniversary summarizes the impact of Scandinavian companies on the Polish economy by analyzing investments made over the past two decades and the scale and nature of trade exchanges.

During this time, the Polish economy and the Polish Nordic economic relations underwent an enormous transformation. Today, a growing part of the local Polish economy and nearly **350,000 employees are involved in the supply chain** for exports to Scandinavia.

The total value of Scandinavian investment in Poland in 2023 has already reached EUR 15 billion. A unique characteristic distinguishing Scandinavian investors is their reinvestment rate, which has reached 70% and is 10 percentage points higher than the average for all foreign investors.

SPCC Reports

The main report was supplemented with in-depth analyzes dedicated to Poland's cooperation with individual Scandinavian countries - **Denmark, Norway and Sweden**. All reports were prepared in cooperation with three respective Embassies.



- Denmark's direct investments in Poland amount to EUR 6 billion and account for **nearly 40%** of all Scandinavian investments in our country
- There are over 750 companies with origin in Denmark operating in Poland, employing more than 75,000 people



- Norway plays a critical role in ensuring access to raw materials for modern processing industries and contributing to energy security
- Since 2004, Poland has received approximately 2 billion euros from the EEA Grants and Norway Grants with 925 million euros scheduled for the coming years
- Norwegian investments in Poland amount to nearly 4
 billion euros



- Swedish investors have consistently treated Poland as a long-term commitment systematically reinvesting over 90% of their profits
- Since Poland joined the European Union in 2004, trade between Poland and Sweden surged nearly 400%, increasing from EUR 4.2 billion to EUR 20.6 billion by 2023




Media Debate




