KEY FIGURES

Significant employers



700 companies with Swedish origin operate in Poland
109,000 people **are employed** by Swedish companies
150,000 people in Poland are engaged in the supply chain for exports to Sweden

Long-term and responsible investors



5,5 bln euro the value of Swedish investments in Poland
220% **the increase** in Swedish investments in the past 20 years
93% of profits generated in Poland **Swedish investors reinvest** (the average for foreign investors is 58%).

Strong trade partners



20,6 bln euro is the total trade turnover between Poland and Sweden in 2023
395% **is the growth in trade turnover** between Poland and Sweden from 2004 to 2023
Sweden is **the largest trading partner** among the Nordic countries in terms of trade turnover

Solid contributors to a strong Polish economy



0,5% GDP = 11 bln PLN direct contribution of Swedish-owned companies to Poland's GDP
1% GDP share of Polish GDP associated with the entire supply chain for Polish exports to Sweden, largely produced by subcontractors for direct exporters

Partners in know-how exchange



4,5% of the workforce in Swedish owned companies in Poland is involved in **research and development** (comparable to 1,5% in the economy)*
Swedish investors convey production know-how to the Polish market through various channels:

- sharing insights on manufacturing processes with subcontractors and partners
- collaborative efforts aimed at improving the quality of ordered products and services
- employee training, employee rotation within local enterprises and promotions to managerial roles on an international level
